President's Report - Dug Stetter:

Treasurer's Report - Sherry LaBree:

- Opening balance June 1 - June 30 \$14,973.06. Had some Trick or Trot registrations coming in, closed at \$15,838.24
- Opening balance July \$15,838.25 more registrations and sponsorship coming in, Moe's Terrier Trot sponsor came in, closed with \$16,908.68
- Scholarship recipient James did get in touch, will be going to Hillsborough Community College

Membership & Marketing Director's Report - Mart Stetter:

Race Coordinator's Report - Ed Gillen:

- Ed has been busy meeting with and communicating with area race directors who are seeking timing services from Zoomers. Zoomers has signed a contract with Habitat for Humanity to time the Turkey Trot on November 27th. We are waiting to hear from Scrub Jay 5k/10k (February 2015)
- Zoomers has announced three of their own races: Trick or Trot 5k (Oct. 18), Save the Daylight ultra (Nov. 1/2) and Moe's Terrier Trot (Dec. 7). We are still moving forward as a club to host additional group runs and races.

Steve

- Their mission has changed and they are now focused on developing a facility to house adult autistic people. To house 48 adults cost about \$48 million dollar raised. Money from the half will go in escrow account to get property going to build a facility for the adult autistic. Zoomers has been with them for 8 years, and they are here to make sure that Zoomers can be involved. Ed indicated we will, group all agreed. He asked that if we are not timing, if we would still support.
- April is world Autism Awareness month - so it makes sense to change the date from February to April.

Race Director's Report (Trick or Trot) - Ed Gillen:

- We lost title sponsor last year but sponsorship is past what we got last year.
- We have 3 levels - Bronze \$100 - gets your name on the shirts and you can put stuff in the packet. Silver is \$250 - you get everything that Bronze gets plus 2 registrations. Gold is \$500 and you get everything Silver gets plus you can set up at the event and publicize.
- Ed, with the help of other Zoomer members, have secured numerous sponsorships for the Trick or Trot 5k. He reported that we are on track to meet projected race budget. Registrations are on track to meet last year's numbers. Remaining months will focus on race details. He reported that Southwest Airlines has once again donated two roundtrip airfare tickets.

Race Director's Report (Save the Day Light 24 Hour Ultra) - Don Fialka:

- Doing well so far - 7 registered so far. Don't need that many volunteers or sponsorships. Prime Sponsor is Fir to Run - Kimmie is giving bibs, salt tablets, and some nutrients. Bibs will be colored coded so we know who is running 6 hours, 12 hours and 24 hours. Sherry from Foot Landing is giving gift certificates for male and female who can get the most hours in a set period of time. There will be a massage table. Would like to get blister paramedic - maybe Scott Labree can do it. 3 ¼ mile loop at Anne Denver.

Moe's Terrier Trot - Krissy Varner

- Krissy was not present but Dug gave some information about it. Will be held on Dec 7th - Moe's is the title sponsor, they are donating rice and beans for every runner to Harry Chapman Food Bank.
