

## **ZOOMERS MEETING – APRIL 6, 2011**

1. President – Kimmi van der Veen introduced MC and Chris Heffner to speak about Team in Training. **Team in Training** is an organization that trains volunteers to raise money for Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. The Team in Training members are provided a coach to train for runs, their registration fee for specified races, team runs, and refreshments after a major race. The main goal is to provide needed funds to support research for cancers such as Leukemia and Lymphoma. MC and Chris are working hard to get the patient services for cancer patients in our area. They want Team in Training to show up at every race and put up a tent to provide a visual presentation and inspire people to get in better condition by running and also provide funds to find the causes of blood cancers. Research into blood cancers has opened up the door to finds drugs to help with lung and other forms of cancer. TNT hopes to provide more patient services, financial aid, provide more information to the general public, encourage runners and fund research which recently has found new ways of fighting not only blood cancers, but has lead to drugs for other forms of cancer. Racing for charity has become increasingly popular. It brings a sense of purpose to your training and gives you the opportunity to help others. Team in Training (TNT) has raised over \$1 billion to fund research into blood cancers. In 2010 – 39 new drugs have been discovered to help fight various cancers. The Zoomers website will have additional information about TNT sponsored runs. Stop by the TNT tent at local races to get more information about this valuable program. Sherry La Bree suggested that we devote the “Focus on a Member” spotlight to TNT. MC and Chris Heffner got involved with TNT starting with the loss of Chris’ Mom and seeing the need for these services and funds.
2. Secretary’s report- The minutes for the March 2011 meeting are on the Zoomers webpage and also will be in the next newsletter.
3. Treasurer’s Report – Carol Geyer reported that Zoomers were paid \$3369.04 for timing races. Payments came from: Hands Across the Harbor, Veteran day, Boca Grande, County Line, Sharky’s, Resolution Run, Harbor Run/ Harbor Walk and Senior Games. Zoomers balance at the beginning of March 2011 was \$5298.37. Zoomers’ biggest expense was \$1314.12 for race supplies. Most of that money was spent on our new timing clock which cost \$1090. Runners have certainly appreciated our new clock which has been at the last several races. We also had some receipt and expenditures from the banquet in March. Zoomers treasury balance at the end of March was \$6601.93.

4. Membership – Teri Hart couldn't make the meeting but emailed the new membership numbers. We have 93 single members, 45 families (106 members), and 13 students for a total of 212 Zoomer members.
5. Race Director's report – Bob Geyer reported that all energy is being directed towards the Shark's Tooth 10 K on Saturday, April 9<sup>th</sup>. Lots of time has been put into this massive race which already has over 500 registered and will probably by race day have 700 plus runner.
