

## **Zoomers Business Meeting Minutes – February 2, 2011**

1. President – Kimmi van der Veen opened the meeting and welcomed those present. Bill Cotter is a new member and was welcomed. Bill said he always liked running. He has run all sorts of races and marathons with his daughter. He just enjoys running.  
Steve Ellis- has been running some of the Zoomers races. Last Saturday Steve ran the Hands Across the Harbor race. We hope to see Steve at more Zoomer meetings and races.
2. Secretary's Report – the January secretary's report is on the webpage and in the newsletter.
3. Treasurer's Report – Carol Geyer reported that the expenses and receipt for January have a lot to do with the Hands Across the Harbor Race. During January we received \$2,215.00 but most of that money was due to the HAH race. Other Zoomer funds came from membership, newsletter advertising and a payment for race timing. Expenses this month were also mostly connected with the HAH race. Our total currently is \$5685.39. When all the expenses and receipts for the HAH race are completed we should have made \$1,000 for all the work put into the race by Zoomers. Bob and Carol have been attending meetings for the past several months to help organize the HAH race.
4. Membership and marketing – Teri Hart reported that currently we have 79 single Zoomer memberships, 39 families with a total of 96 members and 10 students. As of the end of January we have 185 Zoomer members. In the future Zoomers will receive an email the month their Zoomer membership is up. Remember to be in the Race Series you must be a Zoomer member. Please encourage other runners to join Zoomers as we are trying to promote and provide better running opportunities in this area.
5. Race Director's Report – Bob Geyer reported that we have 24 races lined up for this year.
  - We have already completed 3 (Resolution 5K, Lamarque 5K and Hands Across the Harbor).
  - 2 races scheduled for February (Harbor Height 2/26 and Boca Grande 2/27). Registration forms are on the webpage and at Smoothie King in North Port.
  - March has 5 scheduled races. March 5<sup>th</sup> is the Friend's Day 5K. Senior

Games on 3/6 and 3/13. The Senior Games will be held at St. Paul's Linear Park in South Gulf Cove. Sharkey's 8K on 3/19 at Sharkey's restaurant in Venice and Harbor Run/Harbor Walk on 3/26 at Laishley Park in Punta Gorda.

- In April the Shark's Tooth 10K at Venice Airport on April 9<sup>th</sup>, and Girls on the Run will start at Port Charlotte High School on April 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - May's races will include Miles for Smiles at Charlotte high School on May 1<sup>st</sup> and the County Line 5K at Englewood Beach on May 7<sup>th</sup>. A new race has been added on the schedule called Divas and Dudes 5K at Payne Park in Sarasota on May 14<sup>th</sup>.
  - July will have the traditional Firecracker 5K in North Port on July 4<sup>th</sup>.
  - August 6<sup>th</sup> will be the Run for a Reason 5K sponsored by 1<sup>st</sup> Alliance Church. The Crab Crawl 5k will be held at Charlotte Sports Park on 8/20.
  - September will be started by the annual MDA 5K at the Olde world Restaurant in North Port on Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup>. Gasparilla 4miler will be held at Boca Grande Community Center on 9/24.
  - October 12<sup>th</sup> is the date for the Free to Breathe 5K at Charlotte Sports Park and the Pumpkin Y 5K will be held at the Bayfront YMCA in Punta Gorda on 11/19<sup>th</sup>. The annual Turkey Trot will be held on 11/24 at Edison College.
  - Frosty 5K will be held on Dec. 17<sup>th</sup> at Twin Lakes Park in Sarasota.
6. Webpage Director's Report – Lou van der Veen stated that the Race Series page is being worked on. All race flyers that have been received are on the webpage. Contact Lou if you have any questions.
  7. Race Series Committee - There are 9 race series winners for last year. A committee met on January 23<sup>rd</sup> and organized the Race Series for 2011. The Race Series for 2011 will consist of 11 races. The races selected are – Lamarque – 1/15, Boca Grande – 2/27, St. Patty's Day 8K – 3/19, Shark's Tooth 10K – 4/9, County Line 5K – 5/7, Firecracker 5K – 7/4, Run for a Reason 5K – 8/6, MDA 5K – 9/3, Gasparilla Island 4 miler – 9/24, Free to Breathe 5K – 11/12 and Frosty 5K – 12/17. The results will be based on runner's best 6 races. If you run fewer than 6 races you will still be eligible. Complete details will be on the webpage.
  8. Special Events Committee – **Zoomers Annual Banquet will be held on Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup> at the Riverwalk Country Club. The cost will be \$25 per person.** Check the web site for more details. We hope to you all at the banquet. Great food, lots of race talk and surprises await those who attend the banquet.
